

## Minimum Graduation Requirements

*Note: These requirements apply to students who begin 9<sup>th</sup> Grade or enter the school for the first time in 2018-19.*

History	4	1 each from the periods – Ancient, Medieval, Modern (as covered in The Great Conversation series), and 1 additional history elective.

Literature	4	1 each from the periods – Classical, Medieval, Modern (as covered in The Great Conversation series), and 1 additional literature elective
Rhetoric	2	Logic 1 & 2, as prerequisites to Rhetoric, may be taken in the School of Logic, grades 7 & 8, or as an elective in Grades 9-12.
Theology	1	May be earned as part of The Great Conversation series.
Math	3	
Science	3	Laboratory sciences
Languages	2*	
Fine Arts	1	
Physical Education, Health & Safety	1	
Electives	3	In addition to the ones listed for History and Literature.

\*A student must have successfully completed Latin through Latin 2 in the Upper School (Grades 7-12). Language credit will be given only for courses completed in Grades 9-12.

In some cases a student may receive credit for a course taken in grade 8, but that will be decided on a case-by-case basis by the WHA Registrar. Courses that might normally be taken in Grades 9-12 may be shown on the official Transcript; however, they will usually not be shown for credit toward meeting Graduation Requirements.

Credits may be earned at Wilson Hill Academy or as Transfer Credits\*\* from their home school or another educational institution.

\*\*Transfer Credits: A student who transfers to Wilson Hill Academy in grade 10 or above or takes courses outside of Wilson Hill Academy in grades 9-12 must submit an official transcript for all coursework for which he/she would like to receive credit toward graduation from WHA. Transcripts will be reviewed, and course credits will be approved for Transfer Credit by the WHA Registrar.

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**A student who wishes to earn a diploma and graduate from Wilson Hill Academy must satisfactorily complete the minimum number of course credits required for graduation and meet one the following criteria:**

- A student who wishes to graduate from Wilson Hill Academy in June, 2018, or in a future year, must meet one of the following criteria based on his/her 2016-17 enrollment status:
  - Students enrolled at Wilson Hill Academy in 9<sup>th</sup> grade or above prior to 2016-17 must satisfactorily complete an average of at least 3 courses (not credits) at Wilson Hill Academy per year for the years they are enrolled in Wilson Hill Academy in order to graduate and receive a diploma from WHA.
  - Students entering Wilson Hill Academy in 9<sup>th</sup> Grade in 2016-17 and following must meet the graduation requirements for credits at WHA and satisfactorily complete at least 12 courses (not credits) at Wilson Hill Academy in order to graduate and receive a diploma from WHA.
  - Students entering Wilson Hill Academy in 10<sup>th</sup> Grade must meet the graduation requirements for credits at WHA and satisfactorily complete at least 10 courses (not credits) at Wilson Hill Academy in order to graduate and receive a diploma from WHA.
  - Students entering Wilson Hill Academy in 11<sup>th</sup> Grade must meet the graduation requirements for credits at WHA and satisfactorily complete at least 7 WHA courses in order to graduate and receive a diploma from WHA
